Accounts, Maintenance and Understanding Campus Security

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

Data security is a top priority in our districts today. In this session you will learn best practices, new tools and how to leverage Calendar Groups and User Groups to simplify this task. You will also learn ways to better maintain staff, parent, and student user accounts.

AdHoc Reporting: Logical Expressions & Functions

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: Intermediate

This session will highlight the use of the function tool, logical expression and aggregate tool in AdHoc. These tools can be used for: Adding & subtracting, logical expressions, adding coalesce, concatenate and constant functions. Participants of this session should be proficient in basic AdHoc with the ability to create query wizards and selection editor filters.

AdHoc: Tips & Tricks to Use District Wide

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

AdHoc is an area of Infinite Campus that can be as overwhelming as it is impressive. Time in this session will be spent showing some unknown ways that AdHoc can be used and embedded into other areas of the product to make your life easier. Participants will leave with the information needed to implement what they see in a matter of minutes.

Attendance Period, Period Setup, Attendance Wizard, Excuse Codes

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin

User Level: All

In this session we will review all of the options for setting up period vs daily attendance, options for attendance codes and the use of the Attendance Wizard. We will also take a look at tools to monitor individual student's attendance.

Beginning of Year Processes

Audience: SIS Administrator

The Beginning of Year Process (BOY) is a very important process to the start of a successful school year. In this session, participants will: View the BOY checklist and understand how to perform the actions on the checklist.

Behavior Tracking & Reporting

Tracking behavior events to their resolution and reporting to GaDOE, parents and staff is a necessary part of school operations. In this session, participants will review: The Infinite Campus model for handling behavior event data; the integrated flow of data from the referral, to the resolution, to home communication; and Proper procedures for safeguarding student privacy.

Building a Master Schedule

Campus Portal for Parents & Students

Participants will review: The types of information available, how to create and maintain user accounts and how to setup the Campus Portal options.

Campus Scheduling Tools for Elementary

Elementary scheduling is becoming more complex each year. There are tools and options available in Campus to help make the process easier than a ton of clicks building sections and rosters. Come away from this session with an understanding of where to start and what can be used to make the elementary scheduling season run smoothly.

CheckMate: Attendance Tracking & Reporting

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

Using our Checkmate tool, you can automate student check in/check out with direct updates to your Infinite Campus database. Checkmate offers: Guest check in/out with name badge printing and a "Who's in the building" dashboard, substitute check in/out with name badges to include the absent teacher's name and reporting for payroll purposes, staff time clock feature with reporting for time and attendance tracking, student notes feature - enter and print student notes to allow for tracking of any variety of notes.

CheckMate Users Group

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

This session is designed for districts who are currently using CheckMate. We will review new and upcoming functionality based on your enhancement requests. We will also share the best practices for kiosk set up and answer any of your questions regarding the tool.

Cleaning Up Census Data

Customizing Campus: Custom Tabs, Fields & Outline Links

Infinite Campus can be modified to meet your needs in many ways. When there is a need to allow for special district practices or for more data, customization is the perfect solution. In this session, participants will learn: What customizations are possible and appropriate, how you can customize Campus Help for district specific instructions and how to create tabs and fields to capture information easily.

Data Extract Utility: How to Use with AdHoc and More

Use the Campus Data Extract Utility and the wealth of information maintained in your Infinite Campus database to automate data with external databases and third-party systems like library and transportation. Set up and schedule flat file data extracts to provide precisely the right data to the right place, in the right form, at the right time. Then, reverse that for Free/Reduced Eligibility - utilize the Eligibility Import tool to get those statuses set in Campus for the necessary reporting to GaDOE.

Data Viewer/Data Analysis

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

If you are a new user to Campus or AdHoc, Data Viewer and Data Analysis are a good place to start to get your feet wet! We will learn how to create simple reports with drag and drop functionality to see the results in a 'real-time' report.

Development Life Cycle: What's In Development For The SIS

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

Have you ever had a great Idea that would make Infinite Campus better? Do support tickets really go in to "Never Never Land" never to be seen again? Take a look behind the curtain and discover how your support ticket gets attached to an Rx, Maintenance Queue, or development project and in to the product.

District Management of Grading

Are you concerned every year that your teachers don't have their grade books setup correctly? Are they creating categories and weights that make no sense? Learn how to auto-direct your teachers to the correct grading setup defined by your school and/or district's grading policies. This new product provides a machine learned data analysis tool that measures a students' dropout risk based on statistical modeling. Campus Early Warning will not only identify students' overall risk, it will also identify the greatest inhibitor to success and possible focus area for intervention.

End of Year Processes

The End of Year Process (EOY) is essential to the ending of a successful school year. In this session, participants will: View the EOY checklist and understand how to perform the actions on the checklist.

Engage Parents & Students Through Campus Mobile Apps

Meet the NEW Campus Parent and Student Mobile Apps. Discuss how to energize use by your largest user population to improve communication. Bring your ideas to share!

ETCH: More Than Just Errors

This session is for districts who want to learn more about ETCH, a fully integrated error tracking, checking & handling system within Infinite Campus. This tool currently features FTEmate, Student Record, Student Class, Managing At Risk Students (MARS), CCRPI and DATAmate. Attend this session to learn more about these tools.

ETCH Users Group

Free & Reduced Application Management

The FRAM (Free and Reduced Application Management) module provides the tools for processing applications and approving federal meal service assistance for students. We will discuss how to: Review and update processed applications via the household application tool, generate batch approval and denial letters, conduct and report annual Federal verification of applications, take advantage of up-to-date Federal income guidelines, automate the importing of eligibility status with the Campus Eligibility Import Wizard managed by Infinite Campus, complete state reporting of meal status and how to setup and enable Online Meal Applications.

Georgia State Reporting Updates & CPI Reporting

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

In this session, we will review and discuss all of the GaDOE State Reporting updates. We will also discuss CPI Reporting through Infinite Campus.

Get Creative With Standards

There are many different ways to setup your standards to design a report card and make it easier for your teachers and parents. Attend this session to learn a few creative ways to manage standards in Campus.

We will also discover how this data can help provide evidence for professional evaluations of staff and programs.

Health Tracking & Reporting in Campus

The Campus Health Office streamlines the nurse's record keeping so they can focus on the student, while maintaining a full account of activity and daily appointments. In this session, participants will: Be introduced to the information management tools available in Campus Health, review the most efficient setup and learn how to record daily data for reporting.

Improve Parent & Student Communication: Email Messenger

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

A top priority for schools and teachers is keeping their parents and students informed. The Campus Email Messenger is a free tool in Campus that can be used to improve communication. We will discuss how to generate messages to be sent to a mass audience, staff members as well as students and parents.

Letters With Language Translation

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

Did you know that you can now create attendance and behavior letters in any preferred language? Attend this session to learn how this new functionality works!

Managing the Most Common Assessments in Campus

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

Infinite Campus offers several different ways to enter and track assessment data on your students. In this session we will take a beginners look at how to setup assessments, how these can be teacher scored, individual student entries and mass imports. We will also look at several ways to utilize the assessment data for analysis and reporting.

Managing Students Using the Counselor Module

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

Our Counselors are often overlooked when considering our SIS. This session will cover all of the tools available to Counselors to better enable them to track meeting, documents, academic progress, communication, etc. We will also cover the NEW and IMPROVED Walk-In Scheduler.

Multi-Language Editor

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

Does your district have a need to produce report cards in the primary language of the families in your school? The Campus Multi-Language Editor allows you to support multiple languages when building report cards with grading tasks, standards, and courses. This tool will help you increase communication effectiveness with diverse stakeholders.

MYAP: Track Graduation, CTAE Clusters and Pathways

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

Not only can you track a student's progress towards graduation in MYAP, now you can track progress and completion of all CTAE Pathways. Career Tech Programs show a student's progress towards completion of that program, including specific course requirements for that career track and any assessments or certificates that need to be taken in order to complete that program.

New Proficiency Based Tools

User Level: All

Infinite Campus shows how a student has performed over time. Regardless of how long you have been scoring students on standards, you already have a standards-based transcript and you might not even know it. The transcript is also interactive and allows for viewing of actual assessments and scores earned in previous year/course combinations.

Online Registration Users Group

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

Bring your ideas and questions to collaborate with other Online Registration User Districts. This is a district-led session that will allow us to get to know one another and share ideas!

Profile Manager

Audience: SIS Administrator/School Admin/Data Clerk

User Level: All

Due to all the changes in SLDS, efficiently managing Profile Manager has become a huge requirement. In this session, we will review the working of Profile Manager, look at a few new things, and answer any questions that you might have. If you know all there is to know about Profile Manager, you might want to think about getting a backup and bring them along with you.

Report Card Audit & Grade Book Setup Verification

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

Would you like to verify that your teachers have their grade books set up correctly for the school year? Would you like to find out if your teachers have all of their grades in before you run the report cards? Participants will learn how to generate the Grading Setup Audit Report and how to trouble shoot teacher grade book and assignment setup issues, as well as generate the Grades Report to discover missing grades.

Report Setup: Report Cards, Schedules and Transcripts

Audience: SIS Administrator

User Level: All

In this session, we will review how to create report card, progress report, schedule and transcript templates to be used throughout the year. We will also cover the maintenance and roll-forward of these reports from year to year.

Response to Intervention

Audience: SIS Administrator

The Response to Intervention module allows you to view and manage RTI student Summary, Team Member, Documents and Contact Log information as well as enter intervention delivery records and finalize a student's RTI plan. In this session, we will review how to get started, support and maintain plans in Response to Intervention.

Responsive Scheduling

This session will cover how to run intervention enrichment courses, build on-demand rosters by student selection and make use of the tools in Campus Instruction including Attendance.

Schedule Prep with Campus Tools

Many think the Campus Schedule Wizard is only to be used to schedule large high schools. This is not true! Schedule Wizard, and other tools in Campus, can be used to automate several aspects of master schedule building at ALL levels. Social Work Activity & Referral Module (SWARM)

This session is for districts who want to learn more about Social Work Activity & Referral Module (SWARM). This tool can be used to track Concerns, Social Worker Referrals, Case Notes, Activity, Group Work, etc. From individual interactions to group sessions, track your minutes, students attending, activities offered and provided. Easily monitor a student's social worker data with a Student Overview dashboard. All of this rolls up for State Reporting without the need for additional logging and manual calculation prior to Student Record.

SPED User Group

SQL 101: Pass-Through Queries with AdHoc

SWARM Users Group

Transfer Students: Transcripts & National Records Exchange

Participants will learn how to manually enter transcript information for a student including school history, courses, and grades. You will also learn how to run the Transcript Audit Report to help look for any items that need to be changed as well as how to make any appropriate transcript edit changes, including grade changes, on a student transcript or from the course level. Lastly, participants will learn more about the National Records Exchange and how it can make the transfer student process easier.

Using Academic Rubrics For Scoring & Communication
